Purpose: To run quality volleyball training in a fun atmosphere that develops skills, builds character and self-confidence, nurtures friendships and helps young people understand the love of Christ.

We are looking for coaches who play volleyball, (no coaching experience needed) are active members of their church community willing to teach and encourage and also be a witness of Christ.

Program Details: For coed for high school-aged youth. Coaches will be assigned a team to oversee (2–3 coaches per team). Some may be asked to lead and demonstrate drills (as your skill allows you to, this will be pre-arranged) each week. Each week will consist of praise time, warm up, drills, activity (icebreaker game, small group lesson or skits) ; scrimmages and warm down. Coaches are expected to help set up and tear down equipment and stay for a short debriefing time at the end.

Commitment:

Due to the nature of the program all coaches are required to:

- Attend the training session. The goals for the training are:
 1. To have a unified style of coaching for the purpose of the program
 2. To build community among the coaches and committee
 3. To equip coaches on how to share the gospel and how to coach

- Commit to the entire duration of the program. However, we do understand that unforeseeable circumstances occur and there are certain life events (weddings, etc) that cannot be moved. We will require you to miss no more than 2 weeks. Please let us know your schedule ahead of time and indicate conflicts on your application.
- (Co-)lead your team in a small group time with pre-distributed material in each week.
- This program is Gospel in nature. Be prepared to share your testimony (preparation during training) to the group
- Attend the retreat and help co-lead a small group and other camp activities.

Application Process:

1. Return of completed application with 2 references ASAP. (use attached forms)
2. Interview with a committee member (you will be contacted when we receive your application). Interview is about 45 minutes.
3. Returning coaches from Spring & Summer 2009 must fill out the returning coaches application.
4. Once we have your complete application, you will be notified within 2–3 weeks if you have been accepted or not via email and/or letter by post.
